RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

You must agree to these rules in the exhibitor's contract.
Keep this document and a copy of your vendor contract for your records.

Setting Up

- * The Red Nation Indian Art Market is an **OUTDOOR** event held at the LA Plaza, so plan accordingly.
- * We expect all exhibitors to maintain a level of professionalism and require that all table covers fall to the ground.
- * Exhibitors may set up no earlier than 9:00 a.m. on Sunday, October 7th, 2018. Keep in mind you have 2 hours for set-up. Set up is 9:00 a.m. on Sunday. NOTE: TIME IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE.
- * Exhibitors hours of operation: Sunday, October 7th, 2018 from 4:00pm -8:00pm.
- * Exhibitors must be present to man their booths no later than 2:00 p.m.
- * Exhibitors may share booth space, provided all parties sign a vendor contract.
- * Exhibitors spaces are approximately 10 ft. x 10 ft.
- * Exhibitors must provide their own canopies, tables, chairs, etc.
- * No electricity provided.
- * Each exhibitor must dispose of their booth-generated trash by taking it to the dumpsters. Exhibitors may not leave any trash in the receptacles used by the visitors. Please bring your own trash bags and other cleaning supplies.
- * **IRON-CLAD RULE: CANOPIES CANNOT BE ANCHORED WITH STAKES** – canopies can be anchored **ONLY** using sand bags or water cans! This will be enforced.

Security will be provided. Red Nation Celebration, Red Nation Film Festival, Red Nation Indian Art Market and its members and partners, and LA Plaza will not be held responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged items.

Parking

- * Vehicles will only be allowed to park briefly in the loading area for set-up and take-down.
- * Sunday, October 7th Parking is available near LA Plaza in Local Parking Lots.

Safety

- * Vendors must abide by all fire codes – no fires of any kind.
- * No animals of any kind are allowed.
- * Absolutely no drugs, alcohol, or firearms are allowed.

General Responsibility

- * Each exhibitor must make sure their booth is not left unattended during the Festival.
- * Red Nation Celebration, Red Nation Film Festival, Red Nation Indian Art Market and LA Plaza will not be held responsible for any theft or damage.
- * Each exhibitor should be neighborly to others at all times.
- * Each exhibitor will clean up his booth space before leaving.

Please remember that your actions as a booth vendor reflect on the Red Nation Celebration Institute, Red Nation Film Festival, Red Nation Indian Art Market organization and LA Plaza and that your professional conduct this year will influence the acceptance of your applications for future Red Nation Indian Art Market events.

Any violation of the above rules can be grounds for your expulsion by the Red Nation Film Festival Committee. To guarantee the future of the Red Nation International Film Festival & Indian Art Market, we ask that you to conduct yourselves in an appropriate and respectful manner.

The Red Nation Film Festival Committee, LA Plaza, will NOT be responsible for damaged, lost, or stolen items. The Red Nation Film Festival Committee reserves the right to limit the sale of items it finds offensive to American Indian Indigenous people or specific tribes (such as artifacts, religious or ceremonial items, or non-native indigenous goods).

All exhibitors must begin break-down at **8:00pm on Sunday, October 7th, out by 10:00pm.**
